A double-digit rebounding deficit combined with 50 percent shooting from the field for Connecticut was too much for the Shock to overcome as they fell to the Sun, 101-89, at the BOK Center on June 29. The loss was the Shock's ninth in a row and fourth straight at home. Led by Tina Charles' double-double - 16 points and 12 rebounds - the Sun were plus-16 on the boards (41-25) and led at the end of each quarter despite the 10 lead changes throughout the game. The Shock were once again led in scoring by Scholanda Robinson who finished the game with 19 points and has led Tulsa in scoring in five consecutive games. Tiffany Jackson (10 points), Kiesha Brown (12) and Jennifer Lacy (12) also scored in double-digits for the Shock. Shanna Crossley missed her fourth consecutive game with a lower leg injury and as a result, the Shock only shot 3-of-13 from three point territory. Tulsa also gave up 14 offensive rebounds to the Sun who were able to record 18 second chance points and 34 points in the paint total.

The Tulsa Shock built a 13-point lead in the third quarter, but was not able to hang on as the Seattle Storm came back to win 83-72 at the BOK Center on Sunday afternoon. Seattle trailed by five in the fourth quarter before surging to a 21-0 run in four minutes to put the game out of reach for the Shock. Tulsa had three players score in double figures, with Scholanda Robinson scoring 16, Tiffany Jackson with eleven and Alexis Hornbuckle with ten. Ten of Robinson's 16 points came in the first quarter, a season high for any Shock player in one quarter.

Two-time MVP Lauren Jackson led the Storm with 24 points and Svetlana Abrosimova came off the bench to add 21 points, 15 more than her average. Starting point guard Sue Bird played just 1:44 before leaving the game due to a lower back injury, sidelining her for the rest of the game. Seattle committed a season high 24 turnovers in the ballgame. the win Seattle

Despite losing their eighth game in a row, the Shock are just two games out of third place in the Western Conference. With the win Seattle improves to 13-2 on the year and a perfect 9-0 in conference play.

An incredible shooting performance from three built an early lead and the New York Liberty never looked back, defeating the Shock, 96-90, to hand Tulsa its seventh loss in a row. The Liberty tied the WNBA record for most three-pointers in a quarter (7) led by Leilani Mitchell's four-three pointers (also tied an WNBA record for most threes in a quarter by an individual), to jump out to a 10-point lead, 29-19, at the end of the first. For the game, the Liberty shot 52 percent from the field and an incredible 63.6 percent from three (14-of-22). The Shock were led Jennifer Lacy's 16 points off the bench. Scholanda Robinson added 14 points and Kiesha Brown had 12 for the Shock who at one point found themselves down by as many as 25 points. Rookie Marion Jones had her best game of the season with eights points, three rebounds and two blocks in over 14 minutes of playing - all season and career highs in her young career. In her return to Tulsa after being traded, Plenette Pierson had 11 points and two rebounds for the Liberty.

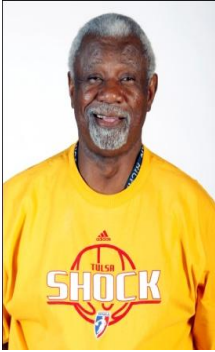

### WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.
- Won first pre-season game, 90-80, over the Seattle Storm.

### GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.
