Ivory Latta scored a team season high 23 points but the Tulsa Shock were not able to overcome the Atlanta Dream, falling 105-89 on Tuesday afternoon at the BOK Center. Latta's 23 points were the most scored by any Shock player this season. She finished with 7-of-12 from the field and 7-of-10 from the charity stripe. Shanna Crossley added 15 points, Nichole Ohlde picked up 14 and Scholanda Robinson added 13 points. The Dream jumped out to a hot start, leading 30 to 16 after the first quarter. They extended their lead in the second quarter, going into the locker room with a 59 to 34 advantage. Tulsa made a comeback in the second half, outscoring Atlanta 28 to 19 in the final ten minutes, but it wasn't enough as the Shock allowed a triple-digit scoring outing for the sixth time this season. Atlanta's Sancho Lyttle finished the game with 20 points and 14 rebounds and Iziane Castro Marques added 23 points to secure the road victory. The Dream are now 16-9 on the season and just one game behind the conference-leading Indiana Fever. Tulsa has lost five straight matchups and 17 of their last 18.

The Tulsa Shock suffered their 19th loss of the season Sunday night as they fell to Seattle, 75-59. Seattle extended their franchise-record winning streak on Sunday, making it 11 straight wins with a perfect home record of 11-0. The win ties the Storm with the 1998 Houston Comets for having the best start through 22 games in WNBA history. Seattle is currently unbeaten by any of its Western Conference counterparts. Shanna Crossley dropped five three-pointers during the game, tying her season high and helping her lead the Shock in scoring with 19 points for the game. Unfortunately, she was the only Tulsa player to score in double digits. The four free-throw attempts made by the Shock, all of which were good, were WNBA season lows for FTs both made and attempted. The Shock allowed Seattle to start the second half with a 14-0 run, taking 4:54 to put any points on the board for the quarter. Lauren Jackson led Seattle, putting up 16 points in 24 minutes of play. Le'Coe Willingham's 10 rebounds was a personal season-high, and Jana Vesela had a career high in both rebounds (seven) and steals

The Phoenix Mercury had another career day as they defeated the Tulsa Shock 123-91 on Thursday night at the BOK Center. The Mercury set multiple WNBA single game offensive records, including points in a single game (123), points in the first half (67) and points in the second quarter (36). Also recorded team season highs in field goals made (46), assists (30) and points in the paint (62). Tulsa trailed by as many as 39 points, the largest deficit of the season for the Shock. Kara Braxton led all Tulsa scorers with 18 points on the night. Four others scored in double figures, including Shanna Crossley, who finished with 12, Jennifer Lacy with 11 and Amber Holt and Ivory Latta with 10 apiece. Latta, the Shock's newest acquisition, has now scored in double figures in five straight games. Phoenix is now 4-0 against the Shock this season. They have scored at least 110 points in three of the four meetings. The game's combined point total, 214 points, is the most scored by two teams in a non-overtime regular season game in the history of the WNBA. The previous record was 212 points set by Seattle and Phoenix on August 4,

- At 34-years-old, Marion Jones is the oldest rookie to play in the WNBA this season

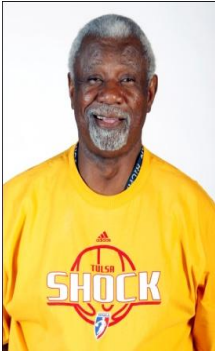

### WNBA CAREER TRENDS AND NOTES

- Hired as the General Manager and Head Coach by the Tulsa Shock on October 20, 2009.

### GENERAL CAREER NOTES

- Won a National Junior College championship in 1980 at Western Texas College
- Head coach at the University of Tulsa from 1981 to 1985, leading Tulsa to the NIT championship in 1981 and compiling a 119-37 record over five seasons.
- Became the head coach of the University of Arkansas in 1985.
- Took the University of Arkansas to the Final Four three times, losing to Duke in the semifinals in 1990, winning the National Championship in 1994 against Duke, and losing in the Championship game to UCLA in 1995.
- Named National Coach of the Year in 1994.
- His teams typically played an up tempo game with intense pressure defense – a style that was known as “40 Minutes of Hell.”
- Winningest coach in Arkansas history, compiling a 389-169
- From 2005 to 2007, Richardson served as the head coach of the Panamanian National team
- In March 2007, Richardson was named the head coach of the Mexican National Team.

### Glossary
